The Helper Project/King Family Foundation Vocational/Technical Scholarship

In an effort to promote vocational and technical education in Carbon County, the King Family Foundation/The Helper Project is providing funding for an ongoing scholarship program.

The purpose of this scholarship is to support students in the Helper community who are pursuing a career in the vocational and technical fields. The goal of the scholarship fund is that recipients will complete industry recognized certifications and degrees and will remain in the community or return to work in the community after completion.

To qualify the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be a Helper/Spring Glen/ Carbonville resident
- 2. Currently be a Senior or a graduate of a Carbon County High School Program.
- 3. Plan to pursue a career in a vocational/technical field which offers industry recognized certification or degree.
- 4. Hold a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher in either a high school or college program.
- 5. Submit two letters of recommendation with the application
- 6. Submit official transcript with the application
- 7. Applications submitted after the deadline will NOT be considered

Application Process

Application can be picked up in the Carbon High School counseling office or online at thehelperproject.net.

Selection Process

Representatives of the The Helper Project Scholarship committee will review the applicants. Each semester, five students will receive a \$1,000 award. Selection will be based on the student's application and letters of recommendation. **An interview may be required.**

Recipients will need to provide proof of college/school registration at Utah State University Eastern or other institution. Prior semester grades will need to be submitted when reapplying. The award will be sent directly to the college you will be attending.

*Prior applications will not need letters of recommendation.

Deadline is June 1, 2022
