

The King Family Foundation Technical and Vocational Scholarship

DEADLINE: JUNE 1, 2023

In an effort to promote technical and vocational education in Carbon County, Utah, the King Family Foundation and The Helper Project have partnered to provide funding for an ongoing scholarship program.

The purpose of this scholarship is to support students in the community who are pursuing a career in the technical and vocational fields. The goal of the scholarship fund is that recipients will complete industry recognized certifications and degrees and will remain in the community or return to work in the community after completing their education.

To qualify the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be a resident of Carbon County, Utah.
- 2. Currently be a senior or a graduate of a Carbon County High School Program.
- 3. Plan to pursue a career in a technical or vocational field which offers and industry recognized certification or degree.
- 4. Hold a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher in either a high school or college program.
- 5. Submit two letters of recommendation with the application.
- 6. Submit a current official transcript with the application.

Applications submitted after the deadline will NOT be considered.

Selection Process

Representatives of The Helper Project Scholarship committee will review the applications. Students who are awarded the scholarship will receive \$1,000 per semester for a total of \$2,000 for the 2023-2024 school year. Selection will be based on the student's application and letters of recommendation. An interview may be required.

*Prior applications will not need letters of recommendation.
